INVITED SPEAKER 1

Wen-Guey CHEAW, is a graduate from Multimedia University where from he also received his Master's in Engineering Science. His research interests include remote sensing technologies, embedded system design and drones. Mr. Cheaw has published 2 papers and has been a research fellow at Chiba University, Japan. He currently develops and deploys aerial drones for industrial use. He has constructed various drones ranging from small quadcopters to large octacopters and very often integrated with other systems such as LiDAR systems and scatterometers. Mr. Cheaw is also actively using DJI drones to conduct survey measurements of landslides and plantations for Public Works and agriculture estates.
