

INTRODUCTION

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

BIODATA OF SPEAKER

Quarrying activities are normally associated with a number of impacts either positively or negatively. Hence, laws are enacted to regulate the activities to protect people and the environment; to enforce rights and to solve complaints or conflicts. With that, laws would prevent or deter people from behaving in a manner that negatively affects the quality of life of other people. Therefore the consequences of breaking the law would call for penalties befitting the offences committed.

In Malaysia, there are several laws that govern the quarrying activities vis-à-vis the State Quarry Rules under the National Land Code 1965, Environmental Quality Act 1974, Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994, Explosives Act 1957, etc. All these laws and their subsidiary legislations aim to protect those working at a quarry and others who may be affected by the quarrying activities that is those living, passing or working nearby, or visitors to the site.

All these regulations, as far as they are concern, require permit or licence holders including the shot-firers to carry out their activities in a safe, orderly, responsible and sustainable manner. Realizing the heavy responsibilities which the owners of quarries have to carry, the IQM with the cooperation of JMG would like to conduct a 2 day basic legislation course for the quarrying fraternity. Owners/Managers of quarries are highly recommended to attend this course.

OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this course are for participants to:

- (a) comprehend available laws applicable to quarrying activities:
- (b) know the legal responsibilities of holders, managers and shotfirers; and
- (c) be better equipped to carry out quarrying competently.

At the end of the course, participants are expected to know the available laws relating to quarrying and the attached responsibilities that come with them. This would make the holders, managers and workers better prepared in dealing with the requirements of the relevant laws.

A 2 hour examination will be conducted at the end of the course and participants who pass the exam are considered to have fulfilled the basic requirements before he can be registered as a quarry manager under JMG.

Hj Mustapha Bin Mohd Lip, FIQ

Hj Mustapha graduated in Mining Engineering (first class honours) from University of New south wales, sydney, Australia in early 1979 and joined Department of Mines upon completion of studies. In 1994 he attended the shotfiring and blast design courses in United Kingdom. He furthered his studies in 1995 and obtained Msc (Environmental Resources) from salford University, Manchester, UK. He rose in ranks in Minerals and Geoscience Department to become the Deputy Director General and retired from the Department in 2015. He was a key person in the formulation and procedures for the certification of shotfirers. Highly knowledgeable in blasting, he has been lecturing in shotfiring courses organised by Institute of Quarrying since 1994.

METHODOLOGY

The course will be conducted in English / Bahasa Malaysia using slides, video, case study and group discussion.
